SUMMARY 21 22 This amendment removes the provision of the bill that changes the salary range for the 23 executive director of the Maine Commission on Indigent Legal Services. It removes the 24 requirement that the commission establish a system to audit all financial requests and 25 payments and retains the requirement that the commission establish a system to audit 26 financial requests and payments, and it removes the requirement that the executive director 27 conduct audits of all financial requests and payments and retains the requirement that the 28 executive director conduct audits of financial requests and payments. It removes the 29 requirement in the bill that the State Controller carry balances of the commission in fiscal 30 years 2020-21 and 2021-22 into the next fiscal year.
