1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §1610-I**, as reallocated by PL 2017, c. 288, Pt. A, §2, is amended
3 to read:

4 **§1610-I. Additional securities; ~~Judicial Branch~~ judicial branch**

5 Notwithstanding any limitation on the amount of securities that may be issued pursuant
6 to section 1606, subsection 2, the authority may issue additional securities from time to
7 time in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$95,600,000 outstanding at any one time for the
8 purposes of paying the costs associated with the planning, purchasing, financing, acquiring,
9 constructing, renovating, furnishing, equipping, improving, extending, enlarging and
10 consolidating new and existing facilities and projects relating to the ~~Judicial Branch~~ judicial
11 branch in the counties of Oxford, Waldo and York, acquiring and improving property
12 relating to the judicial branch in Hancock County and planning for other court facilities.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill authorizes the Maine Governmental Facilities Authority to use previously
15 authorized securities to acquire and improve property relating to the judicial branch in
16 Hancock County.
