18 19 20 21 22 23	This amendment changes the maximum costs to the General Fund and Highway Fund provided in the bill from \$20,000,000 to \$30,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 and from \$25,000,000 to \$45,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. It also strikes the provision in the bill that prohibits lump-sum payments made pursuant to the terms of the collective bargaining agreements funded by the bill from being considered earnable compensation for retirement purposes.
