HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1299, L.D. 1735, "An Act To Fund Collective Bargaining Agreements with Executive Branch Employees"

Amend the bill in section 5 in the 5th line (page 1, line 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$20,000,000" and inserting the following: '\$30,000,000'

Amend the bill in section 5 in the 5th line (page 1, line 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25,000,000" and inserting the following: '\$45,000,000'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 6.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the maximum costs to the General Fund and Highway Fund provided in the bill from \$20,000,000 to \$30,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 and from \$25,000,000 to \$45,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. It also strikes the provision in the bill that prohibits lump-sum payments made pursuant to the terms of the collective bargaining agreements funded by the bill from being considered earnable compensation for retirement purposes.
