11	Amend the bill in Part B by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:
12 13	'Sec. B-1. 36 MRSA §310, first \P , as amended by PL 1981, c. 330 and PL 1997, c. 526, §14, is further amended to read:
14 15	The Bureau of Revenue Services shall hold qualifying examinations for assessors at least 4 as necessary, but not fewer than 2 times each year.'
16 17	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

19 20 21 22 23	This amendment replaces the provision in the bill that reduces the mandatory number of qualifying examinations for professional assessors the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services is required to hold from 4 to 2 per year and instead requires the bureau to hold the examinations as necessary, but not fewer than 2 times per year.
