1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. P&SL 1961, c. 161, §14, as amended by P&SL 2019, c. 12, §1, is further amended by amending the first paragraph to read:
4 5 6 7	Sec. 14. Trustees and officer officers; tenure of office; election to office; organization; vacancies; compensation. All of the affairs of the district are managed by a board of 3 trustees, who must be residents of the district. Trustees are elected for a term of 3 years.
8	Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to November 5, 2019.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12 13	This bill sets at 3 years the term of office of a Boothbay Harbor Sewer District trustee. The change applies retroactively to November 5, 2019, the effective date for Private and Special Law 2019, chapter 12, the most recent law to amend the Boothbay Harbor Sewer District charter.
