Annual public hearing 15 Beginning in In 2022, the office shall convene an annual a public hearing on cost trends 16 no later than October 1st. Beginning in 2023, the office shall convene an annual public 17 hearing no later than October 1st on cost trends and barriers to health care affordability. 18 The hearing must provide an opportunity for public comment on health care cost trends 19 and, beginning in 2023, on barriers to health care affordability. The executive director shall 20 preside over the hearing.' 21 Amend the bill in section 2 in the last paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) 22 by striking out the following: "January 1, 2023" and inserting the following: 'January 1, 23 2024' 24 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 25 number to read consecutively. 26 SUMMARY 27 This amendment requires that the Office of Affordable Health Care, beginning in 2023, 28 expand the scope of its annual public hearing on cost trends to include barriers to health 29 care affordability. The amendment specifies that the hearing must include an opportunity 30 for public comment on these barriers. The amendment also extends the date for the office 31 to report to the Legislature on its study of the effects of policies aimed at improving health 32 care affordability and coverage from January 1, 2023 to January 1, 2024. 33 FISCAL NOTE REQUIRED
