3	Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2015 is enacted to read:
4	§2015. Serial number of stolen firearm
5 6 7 8	A law enforcement agency that receives a report of a stolen firearm shall make a record of the serial number of the stolen firearm if the owner of the firearm provides the serial number to the law enforcement agency. The law enforcement agency shall maintain a record made under this section until the firearm is recovered or destroyed.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	This bill would require a law enforcement agency to make a record of the serial number of a stolen firearm if the owner of the firearm provides the serial number to the law enforcement agency and to maintain that record until the firearm is recovered or destroyed.
