1 Nuisance Species and other persons with relevant experience or expertise in order to make
2 findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, regarding the treatment
3 and protection of lakes infested with invasive aquatic plants or lakes at risk of infestation.
4 Beginning December 15, 2022, the task force is required to report biennially to the
5 department and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over
6 environment and natural resources matters. The committee is authorized to report out
7 legislation relating to the report to any legislative session.
