COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1360, L.D. 1827, "An Act To Permit Limited Delivery of Adult Use Marijuana"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Permit Curbside Pickup of Adult Use Marijuana'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

Sec. 1. 28-B MRSA §504, sub-§2, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2017, c. 409, Pt. A, §6, is amended by amending subparagraph (2) to read:

(2) A drive-through sales window, except as provided by subsection 9;

Sec. 2. 28-B MRSA §504, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2017, c. 409, Pt. A, §6, is amended to read:

4. **Verification of purchaser's age.** A person must be 21 years of age or older to make a purchase ~~in~~ from a marijuana store. A marijuana store may not sell any item to a person under 21 years of age.

A. Prior to initiating a sale in a marijuana store, an employee of the marijuana store licensee shall verify that the purchaser has a valid government-issued photographic identification card, or other acceptable photographic identification, demonstrating that the purchaser is 21 years of age or older.

A-1. Prior to concluding a sale by curbside pickup under subsection 9, an employee of the marijuana store licensee shall verify that the purchaser has a valid government-issued photographic identification card, or other acceptable photographic identification, demonstrating that the purchaser is 21 years of age or older.

B. The department shall by rule determine the forms of photographic identification that a marijuana store licensee may accept when verifying a purchaser's age.
