COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1371, L.D. 1850, "An Act To Ensure the Continuation of Services to Maine Children and Families through the Alternative Response Program"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Provide Funding for the Provision of Services According to the So-called Intensive Care Coordination Using High Fidelity Wraparound Model'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

Sec. 1. Fidelity and referrals. The Department of Health and Human Services shall make reasonable efforts to ensure fidelity to the Intensive Care Coordination Using High Fidelity Wraparound model, as defined by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Title IV-E Prevention Services Clearinghouse, to provide services to families identified as part of a child protective investigation, including appropriate referrals, and to implement the services to maximize available federal funds, including coordination with other department efforts to implement the model.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

IV-E Foster Care/Adoption Assistance 0137**

Initiative: Provides ongoing funding for "Intensive Care Coordination Using High Fidelity Wraparound" services provided to families that are identified as part of a child protective investigation.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,875,000 in fiscal year 2022-23 for Intensive Care Coordination Using High Fidelity Wraparound services provided to families that are identified as part of a child protective investigation. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included in this bill for the FMAP match.
