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

14	are identified as part of a child protective investigation. It requires the Department of					
15	Health and Human Services to make reasonable efforts to ensure fidelity to the model,					
16	including appropriate referrals, and to implement the services to maximize available federal					
17	funds, including coordination with other department efforts to implement the model.
