1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §9726 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§9726. Requirements for on-premises retail licensees</u>
4 5 6 7 8 9 10	<b>1. Toilet facility requirements.</b> Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, premises operated by an on-premises retail licensee that has an occupancy of 30 or fewer persons must have at least one toilet facility. A municipal building code may not require premises operated by an on-premises retail licensee that has an occupancy of 30 or fewer persons to have more than one toilet facility. For purposes of this subsection, "on-premises retail licensee" has the same meaning as in Title 28-A, section 2, subsection 27, paragraph <u>B</u> .
11 12 13	<b>2. Rules.</b> The board may adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
14	SUMMARY
15 16	This bill prohibits municipal building codes or other law from requiring an establishment that permits on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages that has an

17 occupancy of 30 or fewer persons to have more than one toilet facility.
