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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 666, L.D. 1896, "An Act To Allow Heating Fuel and Motor Vehicle Fuel Customers To Opt Out of Paper Delivery Tickets"

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

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Amend the bill in section 3 in the indented paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "requests" the following: 'in writing, which may be through electronic means.'

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Amend the bill in section 3 in the indented paragraph in the 5th line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section." and inserting the following: 'section and must be provided to the purchaser within 24 hours after delivery.'

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Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment directs a vendor to provide a delivery ticket by e-mail if a purchaser of a bulk delivery of liquid fuel sold for heating residential, industrial or commercial space or water or motor vehicle fuel submits a written request to receive a delivery ticket by e-mail instead of a paper delivery ticket. The amendment provides that delivery tickets provided by e-mail must be provided to the purchaser by e-mail within 24 hours after delivery.
