SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 666, L.D. 1896, "An Act To Allow Heating Fuel and Motor Vehicle Fuel Customers To Opt Out of Paper Delivery Tickets"
Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:
'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
'An Act To Allow Certain Bulk Sale Customers To Opt Out of Paper Delivery Tickets' '
Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 13 to 18 in amendment) and inserting the following:
'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting the following:
'Sec. 3. 10 MRSA §2624, as amended by PL 2001, c. 491, §2, is further amended by enacting at the end a new paragraph to read:
Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a vendor using a bulk sale delivery system equipped with the capability of issuing an electronic receipt, ticket or other recorded representation for a bulk sale may give a purchaser the option to receive any information required under this section through electronic means, such as a cellular telephone, a computer or e-mail, in lieu of or in addition to a paper delivery ticket. If the purchaser opts to receive information electronically, the vendor shall obtain the purchaser's consent in writing, which may be through electronic means.'
Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
SUMMARY
This amendment authorizes vendors using bulk sale delivery systems equipped with the capability of issuing electronic receipts, tickets or other recorded representations to give
