COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1406, L.D. 1899, "An Act To Ensure Safe Entry and Access for People Seeking Health Care and Other Constitutional Rights"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B-1 in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "the" the following: 'center of the'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the medical safety zone is measured from the center of the entrance to the building in which patients receive health services.
