9 L.D. 1902, "Resolve, To Establish a Pilot Program To Encourage Climate Education in
10 Maine Public Schools"

11 Amend the amendment by striking out the first paragraph after the title (page 1, lines
12 11 and 12 in amendment) and inserting the following:

13 'Amend the resolve in section 4 in the 4th line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting
14 after the following: "resolve." the following: "The department may apply for and receive
15 funds, grants or contributions from public or private sources to support the purposes of this
16 resolve as long as the person providing the funds, grants or contributions does not have a
17 vested or pecuniary interest in the outcome of the pilot program.'

18 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
19 section number to read consecutively.

20 SUMMARY

21 This amendment allows the Department of Education to receive funding from sources
22 other than the State and the Federal Government by allowing the department to apply for
23 and receive funds, grants or contributions from public or private sources as long as those
24 sources do not have a vested or pecuniary interest in the outcome of the pilot program.
