18 19 20	A. The Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention may not limit the number of hypodermic apparatuses provided by the certified hypodermic apparatus exchange programs to participants.'
21 22	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
23	SUMMARY
24 25 26 27	This amendment replaces the bill and removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause. The amendment allows the Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention to limit the number of hypodermic apparatuses provided by a hypodermic apparatus exchange program.
