COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1415, L.D. 1909, "An Act To Remove Restrictions on Syringe Service Programs"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Amend Syringe Service Programs'

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1341, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 346, Pt. A, §1, is amended to read:

A. The Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention may not limit the number of hypodermic apparatuses provided by the certified hypodermic apparatus exchange programs to participants.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause. The amendment allows the Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention to limit the number of hypodermic apparatuses provided by a hypodermic apparatus exchange program.
