SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1425,
L.D. 1919, "An Act To Encourage Job Growth in the Forest Products Sector through Tax
Incentives"

Amend the amendment in section 4 in §5215-A in subsection 1 in paragraph D in the
last blocked paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "6" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that a qualified employee does not include an individual with
3 months of paid experience trained in mechanical timber harvesting or transfer of forest
products. Committee Amendment "A" provides that a qualified employee does not include
an individual with 6 months of paid experience in mechanical timber harvesting or transfer
of forest products.
