HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1450,
L.D. 1945, "An Act To Regulate the Use of Biometric Identifiers"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 in c. 1057 in §9602 by striking out all of
subsection 4 (page 3, lines 7 to 9 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'4. Financial institution subject to Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act. A financial institution
or an affiliate of a financial institution that is subject to the federal Gramm-Leach-Bliley
Act, Public Law 106-102, and implementing regulations. For purposes of this subsection,
"financial institution" has the same meaning as in Title 9-B, section 131, subsection 17.
"Financial institution" includes a credit union organized pursuant to the laws of this State.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment excludes financial institutions that are subject to the Gramm-Leach-
Bliley Act from the provisions of Committee Amendment "B."
