SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1450,
9 L.D. 1945, "An Act To Regulate the Use of Biometric Identifiers"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 in c. 1057 in §9602 in subsection 3 in the
11 last line (page 3, line 6 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or"

12

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 in c. 1057 in §9602 in subsection 4 in the
13 last line (page 3, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "regulations." and
14 inserting the following: 'regulations; or'

15

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 in c. 1057 in §9602 by inserting after
16 subsection 4 the following:

17

'5. Supervised financial organization. A supervised financial organization or an
18 affiliate of a supervised financial organization that is subject to the federal Gramm-Leach-
19 Bliley Act, Public Law 106-102, and implementing regulations. For purposes of this
20 subsection, "supervised financial organization" has the same meaning as in Title 9-A,
21 section 1-301, subsection 38-A.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
23 section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment excludes supervised financial organizations that are subject to the
26 Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act from the provisions governing biometric identifier information
27 in Committee Amendment "B"
