1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15698** is enacted to read:

3 **§15698. General Purpose Aid Stabilization Fund**

4 **1. Fund established.** The General Purpose Aid Stabilization Fund, referred to in this  
5 section as "the fund," is established as an Other Special Revenue Funds account within the  
6 department for the purposes specified in this section.

7 **2. Nonlapsing.** Any unexpended balances in the fund may not lapse but must be  
8 carried forward.

9 **3. Fund purposes.** Allocations from the fund must reduce loss of general purpose aid  
10 to a school administrative unit.

11 **4. Report by State Controller.** The State Controller shall report at least annually on  
12 the fund on or before the 2nd Friday in November to the joint standing committee of the  
13 Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs and the joint  
14 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters. The  
15 report must summarize the status of and activity in the fund.

16 **SUMMARY**

17 This bill creates the General Purpose Aid Stabilization Fund to reduce loss of general  
18 purpose aid to school administrative units.
