Sec. 1. Authority to lease. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
 20-A, section 4103, subsection 2, the board of directors of School Administrative District
 No. 6 may lease the former administrative building located at 94 Main Street in Buxton to
 the Buxton-Hollis Historical Society for a term of not more than 20 years.
