1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2302, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
4 5 6	B. Must have no other lettering on the front or rear, except lettering not more than 4 inches high indicating an emergency exit and a bus number and lettering from the original manufacturer;
7 8	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2302, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
9 10 11	C. Must be painted national school bus glossy yellow, except that the hood may be lusterless black and the wheels and rub rails may be glossy black or, if the bus is an electric-powered school bus, the color painted by the original manufacturer;
12 13	Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §2302, sub-§1, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
14 15 16	D. Must have bumpers of glossy black unless painting is impracticable through use of rubber, reflective material or other devices or unless the bus is an electric-powered school bus and the bumpers were painted a different color by the original manufacturer.
17	SUMMARY
18 19 20 21	This bill amends the laws governing school bus identifiers to allow electric-powered school buses to have bumpers, rub rails and wheels in the colors originally painted by the original manufacturer. It also allows all school buses to display lettering from the original manufacturer and to have wheels and rub rails that are painted glossy black.
