Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Transfer. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State
13 Controller shall transfer \$75,000 from the reserve for tax relief fund for Maine residents
14 established within the Office of the Treasurer of State to the unappropriated surplus of the
15 General Fund no later than June 30, 2023.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
17 section number to read consecutively.
