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SENATE AMENDMENT



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Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment limits the notification by the Board of Trustees of the Maine Veterans' Homes to instances of discontinuation of services at or the closure of a public home for veterans. It shortens the time by which the joint standing committee having jurisdiction over veterans affairs must hold a public hearing to 10 days following notice by the board and removes the requirement that the board wait 90 days following adjournment of the legislative session to which the report was submitted before taking action on the discontinuation of services or closure of the home.
