
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1492, L.D. 2006, "An Act To Improve the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program"

Amend the bill in section 4 in the 2nd paragraph in the 5th line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Services." the following: "The working group shall investigate whether the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program should be operated on a year-round basis."

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
