Amend the bill in section 4 in the 2nd paragraph in the 5th line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Services." the following: 'The working group shall investigate whether the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program should be operated on a year-round basis.'

14 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 15

17 This amendment requires the working group convened by the Maine State Housing 18 Authority to review the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program to investigate 19 whether the program should be operated on a year-round basis.
