Information that directly or indirectly identifies individual persons contained within the registry may be disclosed only in a manner 17 18 consistent with applicable state and federal confidentiality laws and policies. The department may establish data sharing and protection agreements with state, regional and 19 20 national amyotrophic lateral sclerosis registries for bidirectional data exchange, in a manner consistent with applicable state and federal confidentiality laws and policies' 21 22 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 23 number to read consecutively.
