12 **Sec. 8. Outside funding. Resolved:** That the study committee shall seek funding
13 contributions to fully fund the costs of the study. All funding is subject to approval by the
14 Legislative Council in accordance with its policies. If sufficient contributions to fund the
15 study have not been received within 30 days after the effective date of this resolve, no
16 meetings are authorized and no expenses of any kind may be incurred or reimbursed.

17 **Sec. 9. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following
18 appropriations and allocations are made.


