COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1499, L.D. 2017, "Resolve, Regarding Monitoring of and Reporting on Energy Use Data Standards and Online Energy Data Platforms"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "utilities" the following: 'and natural gas utilities'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment directs the Public Utilities Commission, when gathering information on metering and energy data, to seek the information from natural gas utilities as well as transmission and distribution utilities.
