19 20 21	A. Provide written notification regarding the prohibition in subsection 4 to any person in the State that, prior to January 1, 2022, received such foam from the manufacturer for sale, distribution or use in the State; and

28	This amendment amends the law regulating firefighting and fire-suppressing foam to
