Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph O in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1,
12 lines 20 and 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~other jurisdictions, including~~
13 ~~other states, United States territories,~~" and inserting the following: 'other jurisdictions,
14 including other states, United States territories.'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph P in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1,
16 lines 33 and 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~other jurisdictions, including~~
17 ~~other states, United States territories,~~" and inserting the following: 'other jurisdictions,
18 including other states, United States territories.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
20 section number to read consecutively.

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
SUMMARY
