HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1517,
L.D. 2035, "An Act To Make Changes to the Laws Regarding Licensure of Certain
Individuals from Other Jurisdictions"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph O in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1,
lines 20 and 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~other jurisdictions, including
other states, United States territories,~~" and inserting the following: 'other jurisdictions,
including other states, United States territories,'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph P in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1,
lines 33 and 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~other jurisdictions, including
other states, United States territories,~~" and inserting the following: 'other jurisdictions,
including other states, United States territories,'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment restores language that applies certain documentation and fee waivers
to individuals educated or trained in other jurisdictions inside the United States.
