administrative penalties authorized under Title 35-A, section 1508-A, ending the assistance and recouping all or part of any assistance already provided for the assisted project or directing that, in order for the entity to receive continued assistance, the entity must meet the requirements of this section and pay remedial compensation to any employees who were not paid at least the prevailing rate for wages and benefits.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

### SUMMARY

This amendment allows a person who enrolls in a Maine community college no later 10 than during the 2023-2024 academic year to qualify for free tuition.

This amendment also amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1312, subsection 4, as enacted by Public Law 2021, chapter 705, to specify that, in addition to being considered a material breach of the instrument under which assistance is provided, a violation of a provision of Title 26, chapter 15 subjects an entity that receives state assistance for an assisted project to the enforcement-and penalty provisions of Title 26, chapter 15.

## **Fiscal Note**

Implements intent for free tuition - Maine Community College System Minor revenue increase - General Fund

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

In accordance with the intent of LD 1995, the supplemental budget, this amendment extends free tuition to eligible students through the 2023-24 academic year. The funding for this extension was already included in LD 1995 and no additional funding is required.

Providing that an entity that receives state assistance for an assisted project is subject to the enforcement and penalty provisions of Title 26, chapter 15 may result in a minor increase in General Fund revenue from the assessment of fines.
