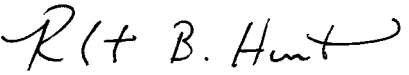

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1043, sub-§31 is enacted to read:

31. Mail. "Mail" includes delivery by United States Postal Service, private carrier or electronic mail.

SUMMARY

This bill adds a definition of "mail" applicable in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, chapter 13 that includes delivery by postal service, private carrier or electronic mail.
