## An Act to Impede the Transfer of Firearms to Prohibited Persons

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §394 is enacted to read:
3	§394. Prohibited sale or transfer of firearms to certain persons
4 5	1. <b>Definitions.</b> As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
6	A. "Firearm" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 2, subsection 12-A.
7 8	B. "Sell" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 554-A, subsection 1 paragraph C.
9 10	C. "Transfer" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 554-A, subsection 1 paragraph A.
11 12 13 14	2. Sale or transfer prohibited. A person may not knowingly or intentionally sell of transfer a firearm to a person who is prohibited from owning, possessing or having under that person's control a firearm pursuant to section 393 and who does not have a permit issued under section 393.
15	Violation of this subsection is a Class D crime.
16	SUMMARY
17 18	This bill prohibits the sale or transfer of a firearm to a person who is prohibited from owning a firearm, possessing a firearm or having a firearm under that person's control.
