1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1304, sub-§1-D is enacted to read:
3	1-D. Rules; beneficial use of solid waste. Rules adopted or amended pursuant to this
4	section relating to the beneficial use of solid waste are major substantive rules as defined
5	in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A, except that rules amending screening levels for
6	beneficial use that are derived using the standard risk protocols of the United States
7	Environmental Protection Agency are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter
8	<u>375, subchapter 2-A.</u>
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill provides that rules of the Board of Environmental Protection relating to the
11	beneficial use of solid waste are major substantive rules, except for certain rules amending
12	screening levels for beneficial use, which the bill specifies are routine technical rules.
