1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1066, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 595, §2, is amended to
3	read:
4	4. Program requirements. The program shall make available to providers vaccines
5	as determined by the board pursuant to subsection 3, paragraph E. The board may not
6	include on the list of vaccines under subsection 3, paragraph E any vaccine for coronavirus
7	disease 2019, also known as COVID-19.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill prohibits the inclusion of any vaccine for COVID-19 on the list of vaccines
10	available through the Universal Childhood Immunization Program.
