1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §10911** is enacted to read:

3 **§10911. Printing services to the general public**

4 The university may not charge less than local market rates to the general public for the
5 use of any university or university-subsidized printing services. For the purposes of this
6 section, "general public" means any person, group or organization not affiliated with the
7 university.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill prohibits the University of Maine System from providing printing services to
10 the general public at less than market rates.
