1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1752, sub-§3-B, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2015, c. 267, Pt. OOOO, §2 and affected by §7, is amended to read:
4	C. Water, including Flavored, mineral bottled and carbonated waters and ice;
5 6 7	Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §1752, sub-§3-B, as amended by PL 2019, c. 231, Pt. A, §§5 and 6 and PL 2021, c. 669, §5, is further amended by amending the 2nd blocked paragraph to read:
8 9 10	"Grocery staples" includes <u>drinking water</u> , bread and bread products, jam, jelly, pickles, honey, condiments, maple syrup, spaghetti sauce or salad dressing when packaged as a separate item for retail sale.
11	SUMMARY
12 13	This bill expands the sales tax exemption for grocery staples to include drinking water other than flavored, mineral bottled and carbonated waters.
