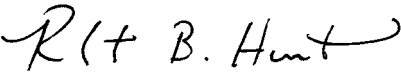

2 **Sec. 1. 34-B MRSA §1208, sub-§8**, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 673, Pt. SSS, §2, is
3 repealed.

4 **SUMMARY**

5 This bill removes the requirement that service providers contracted by the Department
6 of Health and Human Services charge fees for services for children with mental health
7 needs, intellectual disabilities or autism and their families.
