COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 54, L D 86, "An Act to Restore the Former State of Maine Flag"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §206 in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 17 in L D) by inserting after the following "model" the following 'once approved by the Secretary of State'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that a flag made in accordance with the description proposed in the bill must be approved by the Secretary of State prior to being kept in the office of the Adjutant General
