1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1661-D is enacted to read:
3	§1661-D. Propane gas; minimum usage or tank rental fees
4 5 6	A retail seller of propane gas may not require a customer who purchases propane gas for the sole purpose of powering a residential backup power generator to pay a minimum usage fee or a tank rental fee that is based on usage.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill prohibits retail sellers of propane gas from charging customers who purchase propane gas for the sole purpose of powering residential backup power generators a minimum use fee or a tank rental fee that is based on usage.
