1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3 4	Sec. 1. Boundary line. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a portion of the boundary line between Waldo County and Knox County in Penobscot Bay is as described:
5 6	1. Beginning at a point located at N 44° 12' 36" and W 68° 53' 48" in a southwesterly direction to N 44° 10' and W 68° 55';
7 8	2. Beginning at a point located at N 44° 10' and W 68° 55' in a westerly direction to N 44° 10' and W 69° 0'; and
9 10	3. Beginning at a point located at N 44° 10' and W 69° 0' in a northwesterly direction to a point located at N 44° 14' 57" and W 69° 1' 41".

12 13 14	This bill clarifies and describes a portion of the common boundary between Waldo County and Knox County in Penobscot Bay in order to address a discrepancy between recent maps and the legislative history of the boundary line.
