1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §710** is enacted to read:

3 **§710. Maintenance of circular intersections**

4 The Department of Transportation shall maintain the right-of-way of a circular
5 intersection on a state or state aid highway, including the center traffic island and the
6 perimeter of the circular intersection. For the purposes of this section, "circular
7 intersection" includes rotaries, roundabouts and traffic circles.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill requires the Department of Transportation to maintain the right-of-way of a
10 circular intersection on a state or state aid highway, including the center traffic island and
11 the perimeter of the circular intersection. It defines the term "circular intersection" to
12 include rotaries, roundabouts and traffic circles.
