Sec. 1. University of Maine System study. Resolved: That the University of
Maine System shall conduct a study to evaluate the feasibility of establishing a public
allopathic medical school in Penobscot County.

4 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That, by December 6, 2023, the University of Maine 5 System shall submit a report based on its evaluation in section 1 to the Joint Standing 6 Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The Joint Standing Committee on 7 Education and Cultural Affairs may report out legislation related to the report to the Second 8 Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the University of Maine System to conduct a study to evaluate the feasibility of establishing a public allopathic medical school in Penobscot County. The University of Maine System is required to submit a report based on its evaluation by December 6, 2023 to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs, which may report out legislation related to the report to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
