Testing for Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances"


Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 2. Transfer to unappropriated surplus of General Fund; Department
of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Other Special Revenue Funds,
Fund to Address PFAS Contamination.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
contrary, on or before June 30, 2025, the State Controller shall transfer \$90,000 from the
Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Other Special Revenue Funds,
Fund to Address PFAS Contamination account to the unappropriated surplus of the General
Fund.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by adding a one-time transfer of
\$90,000 from the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Other Special
Revenue Funds, Fund to Address PFAS Contamination to the unappropriated surplus of
the General Fund in fiscal year 2024-25.
