21 22 23 24 25 26 27	This bill amends the provisions of law governing the use of tinted windows in motor vehicles by allowing the use of a tinted front windshield that allows a light transmittance of not less than 75% net of glass and material and the use of side or rear tinted windows that allow a light transmittance of not less than 20% net of glass and material. The bill also repeals the provision of law that requires that front and side vehicle windows contain 2-way glass that provides the occupants with a clear view of the road and a person outside the vehicle with a clear view of the occupants and the interior of the vehicle.
